~~The ratio of child to staff in a family child care home shall be no greater than 10:1~~

~~More than 10 children requires a qualified assistant~~

~~Must follow ratios for a large family child care home regarding ages of children~~

This Staff to Child Ratio Waiver was terminated effective 06/30/20 pursuant to PIN 20-15-CCP.

• **Capacity Waiver**

Capacity for small family child care homes shall not exceed 14 children

No waiver will be granted for large family child care homes to exceed 14 children

• **Criminal Record Background Clearance Waiver**

New staff may start helping care for children immediately upon submission of a request to transfer a current CDSS criminal record clearance or exemption and child abuse clearance.

New staff shall be permitted to start caring for children upon submission of proof of both a criminal record clearance and child abuse clearance from a school district, state, or local government agency so long as the other agency conducted both child abuse background checks and criminal background checks of the individual. Within 5 business days of starting work new staff shall LiveScan to associate to the facility.

All others require criminal record and child abuse clearance prior to starting work

• **Personnel Requirements Waivers**

New staff may start working immediately if they submit proof of a TB clearance current within the last year

New staff can start work as soon as they provide proof of completion of first aid training, which may be completed on-line. At least one person on site shall have a current CPR certification

New staff shall not be left unsupervised while children are present in the facility

• **Ongoing Compliance**

Licensee shall immediately notify the Fresno Regional Child Care office in writing when implementing a waiver and post waiver in public location within facility.

Any revised policies need to be readily available for the public’s review.

The licensee shall comply with directive of a local health department officer. This statewide waiver shall be in effect until the Governor’s Proclamation of a State of Emergency is no longer in effect, or sooner if determined by the Department.

Licensee to continue to follow updates in any additional PINs.
